TREATY AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This **TREATY** is executed on the **12th day of August 2025**, the Head of State / Crown in Right Majagi Larrakia Country, Minister of Energy Innovation and Trade Services TIBNLA, CEO Orbit, Ambassador / Foreign Minister of TIBNLA and Subanen Tribe Acopiado Clan 1750, Opirian Kingdom of the Philippine Islands, Pearl of the Orient Seas by and between:

H.M. JUMA SAMUEL FEJO, Founding Member TIBNLA, **Majagi Larrakia 1600 Countries** Societatum of TIBNLA, Governance Office 35 Howley Cresent Anula Larrakia NT, 0812, **H.E. DENNIS MEROSEVICH**, CEO Orbit, Ambassador / Foreign Minister of TIBNLA, and **H.E. DATO SRIRAM VENUGOPAL**, Minister of Energy, Innovation and Trade Services TIBNLA, herein after referred to as the **COUNTRY A**.

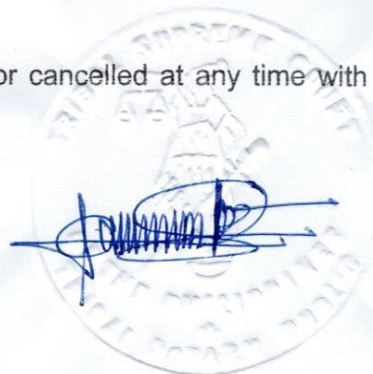

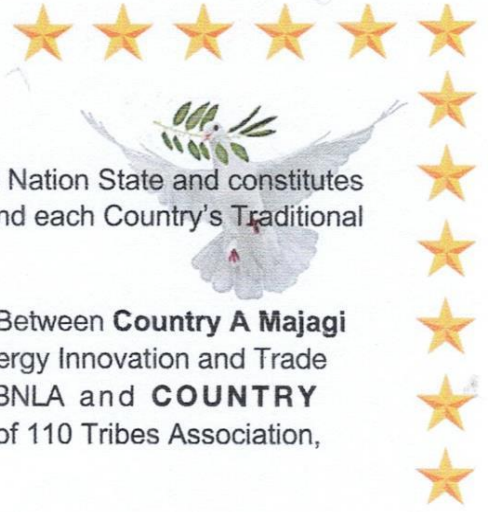

MERCEDITA SUMAGANG ACOPIADO** of Subanen Tribe Acopiado Clan 1750 with postal address at Barangay Culubasa, Bamban province of Tarlac, Region III and both Founder/Chairman/President/CEO/CFO of Subanen Tribe Indigenous Peoples Cultural Communities of 110 Tribes Association, Inc., Subanen Tribes School of International Customary Law, Mandaluyong Subanen Tribe Credit Cooperative, C6 Taguig Agta-Buhi Subanen Tribe Credit Cooperative, Taguig Mangahat Subanen Tribe School of Customary Law Credit Cooperative, Trans Global Royal Ventures Foundation, Inc. herein after referred to as the **COUNTRY B**.

This official document sets out the term and conditions of this Treaty agreement in compliance with Article 1, 3.1 and 7 of the Vienna Convention treaties between States.

Terms.

1. Both Nations agree to conduct all exchanges under friendly relations with the utmost mutual respect for each other's cultural Family's histories religions and business and goods and services exchange.
2. To adhere to the First Lore of the land in respecting the principle of First in Time Best at Lore/Law. Full terms and conditions are under sacred Lore documents found in both Nations Articles, constitution and Governance by Lores/Laws.
3. Assisting each other's growth in international relations in creating trade opportunities in exchange for goods and services, cultural exchange, education and training, Arts, Tourism, Resources and development opportunities.
4. This agreement may be altered, changed, amended or cancelled at any time with 30 days' written notice to the other party.





5. This agreement is signed by the representatives from each Nation State and constitutes the authentication of the Treaty under the Law of Nations and each Country's Traditional Law/Lore of their lands.

Preamble

Recognizing the shared desire to foster mutual respect, cultural understanding, and socio-economic prosperity. Acknowledging the unique cultural heritage and economic potential of both nations committed to sustainable development and equitable cooperation.

COUNTRY A Majagi Larrakia 1600 Countries Societatum of TIBNLA, Minister of Energy Innovation and Trade Services TIBNLA, CEO Orbit, Ambassador / Foreign Minister of TIBNLA and **COUNTRY B. Subanen Tribe Acopiado Clan 5020 Holdings, Inc.** and the Subanen Tribe Indigenous Peoples Cultural Communities of 110 Tribes Association, Inc. Opirian Kingdom of the Philippine Islands.

Article 1: Objectives

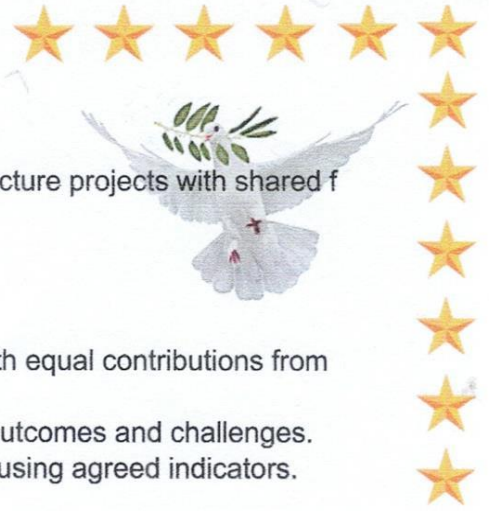
- 1.1 Promote mutual recognition and appreciation of cultural identities.
- 1.2 Enhance socio-economic cooperation through trade, investment, and social Programs.
- 1.3 Foster sustainable development aligned with global standards.

Article 2: Cultural Recognition

- 2.1 Both Parties shall:
 - a. Organize annual cultural festivals showcasing each other's traditions, arts, and cuisine.
 - b. Establish exchange programs for students, artists, and cultural practitioners.
 - c. Protect cultural heritage sites and intellectual property, respecting international conventions.
- 2.2 A Joint Cultural Commission shall be formed to oversee initiatives, meeting biannually.

Article 3: Socio-Economic Development

- 3.1 Trade and Investment:
 - a. Reduce trade barriers by [0.0%] within [2 years] to facilitate commerce.
 - b. Encourage joint ventures in sectors such as [e.g., technology, agriculture].
- 3.2 Social Development:
 - a. Collaborate on educational programs, including scholarships for [300] students annually.
 - b. Share expertise in healthcare, focusing on [e.g., telemedicine, public health campaigns].



3.3 Sustainability: Promote green technology and infrastructure projects with shared Funding

Article 4: Implementation and Funding

- 4.1 A Bilateral Development Fund shall be established, with equal contributions from both Parties.
- 4.2 Annual progress reports shall be published, detailing outcomes and challenges.
- 4.3 A Joint Monitoring Committee shall evaluate progress using agreed indicators.

Article 5: Dispute Resolution

- 5.1 Disputes shall be resolved through dialogue within the Joint Monitoring Committee.
- 5.2 If unresolved, disputes shall be referred to neutral body, e.g., UN mediation].

Article 6: Duration and Termination

- 6.1 This Treaty shall enter into force upon ratification and remain valid for 25 years.
- 6.2 Either Party may terminate with [___ months] written notice, subject to ongoing obligations.

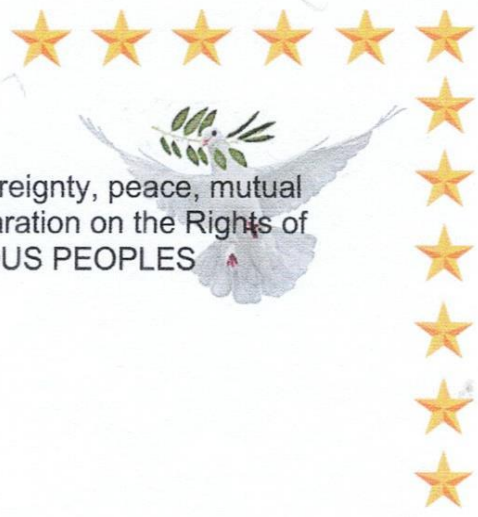
Article 7: Amendments

- 7.1 Amendments require mutual consent and ratification by both Parties.

Article 8: Final Provisions

- 8.1 This Treaty is signed in duplicate copy to **PARTY A**, Country of **Majagi Larrakia** 1600 Countries Societatum of TIBNLA and **PARTY B** Country of **Subanen Tribe** Indigenous Peoples Cultural Communities of 110 Tribes Association, Inc. Opirian Kingdom of the Peoples of the Philippine Islands, and both texts being equally authentic.





Executed this 12th day of August 2025, in the spirit of sovereignty, peace, mutual destiny and cooperation. Observing the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples of the World, August 9, 2025 INDIGENOUS PEOPLES CELEBRATION MONTH.

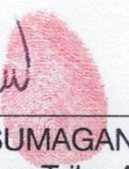

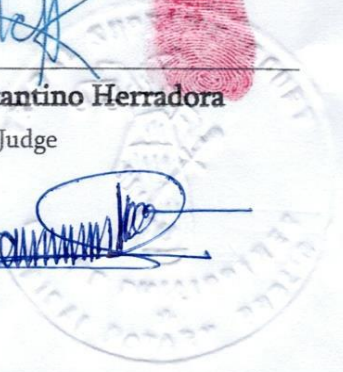

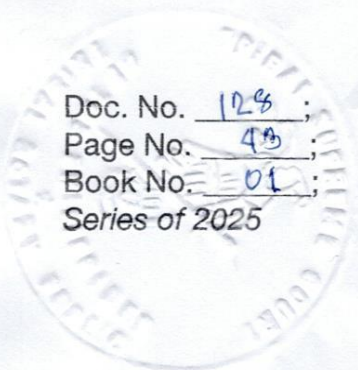
